Resident Engagement






Dedicated Project Team

Number of properties: 230

Funding: SHDF Wave 2.1

Contract Value: £3.5 million

LivGreen were contracted to deliver a 230 home project for Stonewater to achieve EPC ratings of C or above. We achieved this and more by our work resulting in 193 properties reaching EPCs of B and even A. The timescale for this project ran from February 2024 to November 2024.



Number of properties: 800

Funding: SHDF Wave 2.1

Contract Value: £6 million

LivGreen were contracted to deliver a 6 year, 800 property project with MTVH. LivGreen managed full end to end process from stock analysis through to delivery. We are nearing the end of year 1 of this project and so far we have successfully delivered measures such as CWI, HHR Storage Heaters, Energy efficient lighting and Ventilation.

Funding: SHDF Wave 2.1

Contract Value: £6million

LivGreen were contracted to deliver a 200+ homes project for Platform Housing. Works included Solar PV, reroofing, heating upgradades including Air Source Heat Pumps, Loft and EWI, and ventilation.

Funding: SHDF Wave 1

Contract Value: £2.5 million

LivGreen were contracted to deliver bpha's SHDF Wave 1 project which included 110 properties Works included installation of EWI, Loft Insulation, Windows & Doors, Solar PV and ventilation.



Number of properties: 81

Funding: Optimised Retrofit Programme 3.1

Contract Value: £4.6 million

LivGreen were contracted to deliver the Caerphilly council retrofit project under the Optimised Retrofit Programme 3.1, which included the installation of Cavity wall insulation, Windows and Doors, Solar PV and External wall insulation.

Phase one of this comprehensive retrofit project for Caerphilly Council successfully reduced energy consumption and CO2 emissions for 58 sheltered housing units across two sites. By utilising local contractors and suppliers, the project not only contributed to the areas sustainability goals but also supported the local economy in South Wales. The data-driven results demonstrate significant improvements in energy efficiency, leading to long-term savings for residents.

Total Heat Demand: 1,150 kWh/sqm/year

Average Heat Demand Per Property: 42.6 kWh/sqm/year

Total Space-Heating Savings: 62,658 kWh/year

Average Space-Heating Savings Per Property: 2,320.7 kWh/year

Total CO2 Savings: 12,620 kg CO2/year

Average CO2 Savings Per Property: 467.4 kg CO2/year

These results are for our Maesteg Project to 31 homes.
